

**Below are some Windshield Cleaning Basics.**

1. Do use our Clearview or Sprayway plastic cleaner.  
Do Not use a glass cleaner. It contains ammonia which eats away at an aircraft windshield.
2. Do use our microfiber CLEAN cloths  
Do not use dirty rags or paper towels. They both scratch the windshield. There is wood in paper towels. Might as well clean the windshield with a 2x4 if you use a paper towel.
3. Do use UP/DOWN or SIDE/SIDE motions when cleaning.  
Do not use circular motions. You can see people have used circular motions on our windshields and it shows unfortunately.
4. Do clean windows before every flight once the bugs come out (If we ever get spring). Sometimes the line techs are busy and don't get to the windshield after every flight.  
Do NOT leave with a dirty windshield. Bugs on a windshield look just like an airplane in the sky.

The large scratches in our windshields are from people putting their headsets on the glare shields. Unfortunately, it looks like we have quite a few customers/cfi's that do this by how the windshields look.

The above simple rules keep the windshields lasting longer and the customer costs down. Thank you in advance for following the above windshield cleaning basics. Most of you already do an outstanding job with this. We just need those bottom 10% to pull their weight also.
